Financial

Thanks to the hard work in the concession, our 50-50 draw, and gate receipts . The airshow produced. \$4,347.81 in net profit. Concession contributed \$1,060.43 of that profit. Additionally the concession gave out 66 free breakfasts and 68 free lunches. Gate receipts were \$2,620.00.
